

Questions regarding RFP for Portable Restrooms (Trailer Style) and Related Services for Volvo Ocean Race Stopover 2015:

1. **Question:** Is there a job description for restrooms attendants and how many are needed?

Answer: The attendant would be responsible for restocking paper goods and cleaning up the restrooms perhaps on an hourly basis (ie. pick up papers, wipe down counters, emptying trash cans, etc.). Some "office" space will be provided during down between restrooms checks. Service of the restrooms would be within the hours in the scope of work and a truck can be kept somewhere on Fort Adams property in an area that does not interfere with the operation of the race village.

One attendant will be assigned to the VIP area (Ocean Race Club) during all events and one attendant can be shared between the team bases and the media center (which are close together). If it is determined that a second attendant is needed, upon approval from Commerce RI, a second attendant can be added during peak times for the team base and media area.

2. **Question:** Will water and electricity be available to run the portable restrooms (trailer style)?

Answer: Fort Adams has water connection inside North gate and the Department of Environmental Management can run a hose over the wall to the Ocean Race Club portable restroom trailer and provide a hose for Media Center & Team bases portable restroom trailers. DEM has a good amount of hose purchased for past events. Hydrant connectors will be obtained from Newport Fire Department. Electricity is available.
