Ms. Diaz, RN, MPH, is the Behavioral Health Nurse Care Manager at Blackstone Valley Community Health Care. From 2011 through 2014, she served as director of community health services for Lifespan, a comprehensive, academic health system affiliated with the Warren Alpert Medical School of Brown University.
